SEC. 4. And be it further enacted, That this Act is an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and for maintenance of the State Government and having passed by a yea and nay vote by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
