streets, alleys, and construct sidewalks, gutters, and roadbeds in said town, when the necessary property owners petition for same and towards that end. to borrow money on the faith and credit of said Mayor and Common Council of Riverdale, for the purpose of paying for the improvements of said streets, alleys, and the construction of said sidewalks, gutters and roadbeds; to issue bonds or promissory notes therefor, to pay for said improvements and fix the terms and conditions for borrowing money for such purposes: to make the principal and interest of said bonds or promissory notes the direct obligation of said town: to advertise for bids and let contracts of said improvements or to have work done under direct supervision of said Mayor and Common Council: to provide for the repayment of moneys so borrowed or raised by bonds or promissory notes; to provide for the levying and collection of assessments against the abutting property owners on any streets to be improved: to create liens against abutting land and to provide for the enforcement of said liens; to provide for the submission of this Act to the qualified voters of said town.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That Section 5 of Chapter 395 of the Acts of 1929, entitled "An Act to authorize the Mayor and Common Council of Riverdale, in Prince George's County, Maryland, to improve the streets, alleys, and construct sidewalks, gutters and roadbeds in said town, when the necessary property owners petition for same, and towards that end to borrow money on the faith and credit of said Mayor and Common Council of Riverdale for the purpose of paying for the improvements of said streets, alleys and the construction of said sidewalks, gutters and roadbeds; to issue bonds or promissory notes therefor to pay for said improvements and fix the terms and conditions for borrowing money for such purpose; to make the principal and interest of said bonds or promissory notes the direct obligation of said town; to advertise for bids and let contracts for said improvements or to have work done under direct supervision of said Mayor and Common Council, to provide for the repayment of moneys so borrowed or raised by bonds or promissory notes; to provide for the levying and collection of assessments against the abutting property owner on any street to be improved; to create liens against abutting land and to provide for the enforcement of said liens; to provide for the submission of this Act to the qualified voters of said
