of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Revenues and Taxes" as enacted by Chapter 593 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, at its regular 1933 Session.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 200, 201, 202, 203, 204, 205, 206, 207, 208 and 209 of Article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Revenues and Taxes," as enacted by Chapter 593 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, at its regular 1933 Session, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act is an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and for maintenance of the State Government and having passed by a yea and nay vote by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 29 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Elections", sub-title "Registration", relating to registration in the City of Baltimore.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 29 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Elections", subtitle "Registration", be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted with amendments, to read as follows:

29. In the City of Baltimore there shall be a general registration in the year 1936 and quadrennially thereafter. For such general registration the Boards of Registry shall be in session on the Tuesdays, respectively, six and four weeks preceding such regular election, and on the Wednesday next following said Tuesdays, respectively. Before the November election in the year 1934 and biennially thereafter, except in years of general registra-
