228C. A petition for submission of any of the above questions shall be in substantially the following form:

“To the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Somerset County:

The undersigned, legal voters of Somerset County respectively petition that you cause to be submitted, in the manner provided by law, to the voters of Somerset County at the next election the following questions: (Here insert questions)

 A petition may consist of several sheets but each sheet shall be supported by an affidavit by a resident and voter of Somerset County stating that the signatures on that sheet are genuine and that to the best of his knowledge and belief the persons signing the same are legal voters of Somerset County. Where the petition consists of more than one sheet all sheets shall be fastened together and filed with the Supervisors of Elections at the same time.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect on June 1st, 1934.

CHAPTER 86.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Washington County,” sub-title “Williamsport,” said new section to be known as Section 864 and to follow immediately after Section 863 of said Article, providing for the appointment of a Sewerage Commission and prescribing the powers and duties of said Commission.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Washington County,” sub-title “Wil-
