

during one or more years between September 1, 1932, and August 31, 1936, are suspended and non-operative for the fiscal year beginning September 1, 1935, and ending August 31, 1936, and for the fiscal year beginning September 1, 1936, and ending August 31, 1937, any and all other provisions of this section to the contrary notwithstanding.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted,* That Section 195 of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1929 Edition, title "Public Education," sub-title "High Schools," as amended by Chapter 224 of the Acts of 1933, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows:

195. No white high school teacher regularly employed in the public high schools of the State of Maryland shall receive a salary of less than eleven hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,150) per school year, provided that if such teacher holds a high school teacher's certificate of the first class, and has taught in an approved high school of the State of Maryland for a period of one year, such teacher shall receive a salary of not less than twelve hundred dollars (\$1,200) per school year; provided, further, if such teacher holds a high school teacher's certificate of the first class, and has taught in an approved high school of the State of Maryland for a period of three years, such teacher shall receive a salary of not less than one thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,250) per school year; provided, further, if such teacher holds a high school teacher's certificate of the first class, and has taught in an approved high school of the State of Maryland for a period of five years, such teacher shall receive a salary of not less than one thousand three hundred dollars (\$1,300) per school year; and provided, further, if such teacher holds a high school teacher's certificate of the first class and has taught in an approved high school of the State of Maryland for a period of seven years, such teacher shall receive a salary of not less than one thousand three hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,350) per school year.

No white principal of a first group high school shall receive a salary of less than one thousand five hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,550) per school year; provided, that if such principal holds a high school principal's certificate of the first class and has served as principal of an approved high school of the first group in the State of Maryland for a period of one year, such principal shall receive a salary of at least one thousand six hundred and fifty dollars
