

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That said Court shall have full power to fill vacancies on said committee, whenever and however they may occur.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That the total cost of the necessary books, and the making and verification of said indexes, shall not exceed the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) for the Land Records and shall not exceed the sum of Eighteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,800) for the Mechanics Lien and Judgment records; and that the excess fees of said Clerk's Office shall be devoted to the payment thereof, until the same is fully paid.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1935.

## CHAPTER 489.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 11 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Banks and Trust Companies," to be under sub-title "Banking Board," said new section to be known as Section 19A and to follow immediately after Section 19 of said Article, providing for a Banking Board and defining its powers and duties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 11 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Banks and Trust Companies," to be under sub-title "Banking Board," said new section to be known as Section 19A, to follow immediately after Section 19 of said Article, and to read as follows:

### BANKING BOARD

19A. There is hereby created and established a Banking Board which shall consist of three members to be appointed by the Governor. One member of said Board shall be a representative of the Baltimore Clearing House, one a representative of the Associated Mutual Savings Banks of Baltimore and one a representative of the Maryland State Bankers' Association. Each of these organizations shall submit the names of three men qualified for the re-
