

charge of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) for each examination shall be made in all cases, to which shall be added, after first deducting the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) from the total assets of the institution so examined, three cents (3¢) per thousand of such remaining total assets the institution examined may have. When it becomes necessary for the Bank Commissioner to extend his examination beyond the principal office or building, he shall be paid in addition therefor in each case fees at the above rates, except in such cases where further examination is made in the same town or city, when he shall be paid a per diem fee of not more than \$15.00; when such institutions require a special or unusual examination by the Bank Commissioner, he may be paid a per diem fee of \$5.00 where it is necessary for him to count securities beyond the principal office or building. The Bank Commissioner shall collect the amounts named from the institution examined and pay the same to the State Treasurer, and he shall draw, on proper orders, from the State Treasury, the amounts necessary for the salaries and other expenses of his office.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That for the period from June 1st, 1935, to September 30th, 1937, from the amounts paid to the State Treasurer resulting from the increased examination and other fees as provided for in this section, the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) shall be allocated to the use of the State Bank Commissioner for the payment of such increases in salaries, including the increases in salary of the Bank Commissioner and Deputy Bank Commissioner, as authorized by Acts of the General Assembly of 1935, and the salaries of such additional employees and operating expenses as in his opinion the public business in his charge may require; and the said State Bank Commissioner shall draw, on proper orders, from the State Treasury, the amounts necessary for the payment of such increases in salaries, salaries of additional employees and other operating expenses as are heretofore provided for in this section. Thereafter, said increased salaries, the salaries of additional employees and other operating expenses shall be provided for in the Budget.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1935.
