CHAPTER 525.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Talbot County," sub-title "St. Michaels," said new section to be known as Section 469A and to follow immediately after Section 469 of said Article, providing advertisements for bids on public work costing more than a certain sum.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Talbot County," sub-title "St. Michaels," said new section to be known as Section 469A, to follow immediately after Section 469 of said Article, and to read as follows:

469A. The Commissioners of St. Michaels shall advertise for bids on all public work to be done by said Commissioners where the cost of said work will amount to One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) or over and the contract for said work shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder; provided, however, that the said Commissioners shall have the right to reject any and all bids.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1935.
