- 9. There shall be issued with every original attachment, but not with other or successive attachments in the same proceeding as authorized in Section 8, a writ of summons against the defendant and a declaration or short note, expressing the plaintiff's cause of action, shall be filed, and a copy thereof shall be sent with the writ to be set up at the court house door by the sheriff, or other officer.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect as of June 1, 1935.

CHAPTER 547.

- AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Subsection (4B) of Section 193 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Licenses," sub-title "Motor Vehicles," sub-heading "Brakes, Bells, Lights and Mufflers," as amended by Chapter 554 of the Acts of 1933, providing penalty for violation of law relating to smoke screens.
- SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-section (4B) of Section 193 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Licenses," sub-title "Motor Vehicles," sub-heading "Brakes, Bells, Lights and Mufflers," as amended by Chapter 554 of the Acts of 1933, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
- (4B) Smoke Screen. No motor vehicle of any kind shall at any time, whether in use or not in use, carry or be equipped with any device, designed, constructed or intended to be used for the purpose of emitting or laying down a smoke screen or emitting or discharging any screen of vapors, gases, fumes or substances of any kind, and it shall be unlawful for any such device, or part of such device, whether in operating condition or not, to be attached to any motor vehicle. Any person violating any of the provisions of this sub-section shall be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment in the House of Correction for a term of not less than one year nor more than five years in the discretion of the Court.
