aforsaid revenue, shall be received and administered by the State Roads Commission and by it apportioned to the use of the twenty-three Counties and expended by the State Roads Commission for the construction of Lateral Roads forming part of the State or Federal System of highways, and/or the maintenance or reconstruction of approved and unimproved County roads including the cost of supervision thereof, and also including allotments as may be made by County Commissioners to incorporate Towns, and/or the payment of so much of the allotment to each County as may be applied to existing Road Bond Debt Service.

Construction of streets, highways, and bridges, and other related construction projects within the corporate limits of Baltimore City, as may be performed by the Mayor and City Council, and for the maintenance of streets by Baltimore City, reimbursement to be made from this fund to Baltimore City upon the presentation of proper vouchers showing the location of the project and the amount expended thereon, and/or existing highway bond debt service:
