

CHAPTER 17.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 536 of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (for 1930 Edition), title "Talbot County," sub-title "Trappe," as amended by Chapter 500 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland 1933.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 536 of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), entitled "Talbot County," sub-title "Trappe," as amended by Chapter 500 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1933, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:

536. They may levy a tax upon all the taxable property within the Town for all corporate purposes, but the sum so levied shall in no case exceed the sum of fifty cents in every hundred dollars of the assessable property within the limits of said Town of Trappe as may be necessary, in their judgment, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said Town, and they are also authorized to borrow on the faith and credit of said Town any sum of money, not exceeding five thousand dollars, which they may deem necessary for defraying the necessary expenses of said Town, and including therein any improvements to the streets of said Town or other purposes which they may consider for the benefit and advantage of the inhabitants of said Town.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
