CHAPTER 216.

- AN ACT to add a new section to Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County," sub-title "County Commissioners," said new section to be known as Section 84A and to follow immediately after Section 84 of said Article, providing for an audit of the books of the County Treasurer of Charles County.
- SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County," sub-title "County Commissioners," said new section to be known as Section 84A, to follow immediately after Section 84 of said Article, and to read as follows:
- 84A. The County Commissioners of Charles County are hereby authorized and directed to appoint a certified public accountant to audit the books of the County Treasurer of said County at the end of each fiscal year, beginning with the end of the fiscal year 1935—1936. The said County Commissioners shall levy a sufficient sum each year to pay for the cost of said audit.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1935.

CHAPTER 217.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 171 of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Dorchester County," subtitle "Taxes," changing the date for the sale of property for taxes.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 171 of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Taxes," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
