Ninth: That he will not sell any of the beverages herein designated to any person under the age of 21 years of age.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1935.

CHAPTER 235.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Elections," sub-title "Supervisors of Elections," said new section to be known as Section 6A, and to follow immediately after Section 6 of said Article, authorizing Supervisors of Elections to secure a seal with which to authenticate official papers and documents.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new section be, and it is hereby added to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title "Elections," sub-title "Supervisors of Elections," said new section to be known as Section 6A, and to follow immediately after Section 6 of said Article, and to read as follows:

6A. Each Board of Supervisors shall have the right and authority to procure an official seal with which to authenticate the official papers and documents of said Board.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1935.

CHAPTER 236.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 54 of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Workmen's Compensation," sub-title "Claims and Compensation; Benefits," as repealed and re-enacted by Chapter 342 of the Acts of 1931, relating to the jurisdiction of the State Industrial Accident Commission over cases.
