pality may also, in its discretion, allow a discount not exceeding five per centum for prompt payment of said taxes. The taxes so assessed and levied, as well as any other assessment made against real estate shall be collected by distress and sale by the collector of tax as authorized and directed by Section 528 of this Article.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1935.

CHAPTER 245.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 129 of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Cecil County," subtitle "County Commissioners," providing mileage for County Commissioners while attending to their official duties.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 129 of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Cecil County," sub-title "County Commissioners," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

- 129. The County Commissioners of Cecil County hereafter elected or appointed shall receive an annual salary of one thousand dollars in lieu of all other compensation and shall be allowed five cents for each mile actually traveled in the performance of their official duties, and shall be required to devote all their time to the duties of said office. (The President of the Board shall receive one hundred dollars additional pay.)
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That all Acts of parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1935.
