

## CHAPTER 304.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Washington County," to be under sub-title "Schools—Teachers' Salaries," said new section to be known as Section 724A and to follow immediately after Section 724 of said Article, relating to the salaries of teachers in Washington County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Washington County," to be under sub-title "Schools—Teachers' Salaries," said new section to be known as Section 724A, to follow immediately after Section 724 of said Article, and to read as follows:

724A. The salaries of all teachers in the public schools in Washington County shall be the same as for the school year 1932-1933, except that for the period from September 1, 1935, to September 1, 1937, the said salaries may be reduced as follows:

Those receiving salaries under \$1200 shall not be reduced	more than 5%
Those receiving salaries from \$1200 to \$1799 shall not be reduced	more than 5½%
Those receiving salaries from \$1800 to \$2399 shall not be reduced	more than 6%
Those receiving salaries from \$2400 to \$2999 shall not be reduced	more than 6½%
Those receiving salaries from \$3000 to \$3599 shall not be reduced	more than 7%
Those receiving salaries of \$3600 and over shall not be reduced	more than 7½%

Nothing in this section shall prevent the full restoration of salaries of teachers, under the State minimum requirements.

The County Commissioners of Washington County are hereby directed to levy a sufficient amount to pay the salaries as herein prescribed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1935.
