

CHAPTER 333.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 122 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County," sub-title "Fire Companies," including additional fire companies to be levied for and to increase the amount to be levied for such fire companies in Frederick County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 122 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County," sub-title "Fire Companies," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

122. The County Commissioners of Frederick County are authorized and directed to levy on the assessable property of Frederick County for the year 1936 and annually thereafter the sum of \$6,500, to be paid on or before the first day of January, 1937, and annually thereafter on or before the first day of January in each and every year; \$500 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Independent Hose Company of Frederick, \$500 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Junior Steam Fire Engine Company of Frederick, \$500 of said sum to the Treasurer of the United Steam Fire Engine Company of Frederick, \$800 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Brunswick Volunteer Fire Company of Brunswick, \$800 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Vigilant Hose Company of Emmitsburg, \$700 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Guardian Hose Company of Thurmont, \$700 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Middletown Volunteer Fire Company, \$200 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Walkersville Volunteer Fire Company, \$200 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Mt. Airy Fire Company, \$200 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Braddock Heights Volunteer Fire Company of Braddock Heights, \$450 of said sum to the Treasurer of the New Midway Fire Company of New Midway, \$450 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Myersville Volunteer Fire Company of Myersville, and \$500 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Citizens Truck Company of Frederick, the said sums to be applied by the respective companies for their maintenance and support.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1935.
