CHAPTER 366.

AN ACT to authorize the House of Reformation, a body politic and corporate, to transfer all of its property, real, personal, and mixed including all its rights, privileges, franchises and immunities, to the State of Maryland, and to authorize the Board of Public Works of the State to accept a deed therefor upon such terms and conditions as hereinafter set forth, to the end that said institution may become a State institution.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the House of Reformation, a body politic and corporate of the State of Maryland, be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to transfer to the State of Maryland all of its property, real, personal and mixed, including its rights, franchises, privileges and immunities, and that the Board of Public Works of the State of Maryland is authorized and empowered and directed to receive a good and sufficient deed transferring to the State of Maryland all of said property of the said House of Reformation, provided that the State of Maryland assume all mortgage liens and encumbrances against said House of Reformation.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That until the transfer provided for in Section 1 hereof shall have been fully made and completed, and the obligations assumed by the State of Maryland as therein directed, the House of Reformation shall continue to exercise all of its rights, privileges and functions as now provided by law, the same as if this Act had not been passed.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1935.
