three members of said Board shall be affiliated with the same Political Party. The Governor shall have full power to remove any member of the Board for incompetency or misconduct, upon satisfactory evidence being presented to him, and after affording such member with a copy of the charges against him, and an opportunity to be heard.

282B. The members of said Board shall respectively take, and subscribe the oath required by other state officers. They shall have power to elect, out of their number, a President, Secretary and Treasurer, and to adopt such rules and by-laws for the transaction of the business of the Board as they may deem proper.

282C. Each member of said Board shall receive a compensation of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per day for actual service in attending meetings of the Board, which compensation shall be paid out of any monies in the hands of the Treasurer of said Board; provided that the Secretary of said Board may receive such additional compensation as the Board may deem just and reasonable, and for which the by-laws of said Board may provide; provided, however, that the compensation and expenses of said Board, shall, in no event, be paid out of the funds in the State Treasury, or become a charge against the State, it being intended that all compensation and expenses shall not exceed the receipts of the Board, as provided by this Act, and all sums not required to meet the compensation and expenses of the Board shall be paid over to the Treasurer of Maryland for the use of the State, on September 30th. of each and every year.

282D. The said Board shall meet at least once in each month in the City of Baltimore, and shall hold special meetings as frequently as the proper and efficient discharge of its business shall require, and said Board shall adopt such rules and regulations for the examinations of paper-hangers as herein defined, and for the carrying on of the business of paper-hanging in such manner as to protect and promote the public health, safety and general welfare, and when so adopted, such rules and regulations shall have the same force and effect as if herein contained, and the rules of said Board shall also provide for the giving of timely notice of such meetings to all persons who shall have made application for a license as herein provided.
