(b) To the Pastor in charge of St. Anthony's Catholic Church at Mount Saint Mary's, in Frederick County, Maryland, \$25.00.

(c) To the Pastor in charge of St. Joseph's Catholic Church at Emmitsburg, Maryland, \$25.00.

(d) To the Sisters of Charity of St. Joseph's Catholic Church at Emmitsburg, Maryland, \$100.00.
