diate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Approved April 10, 1931.

CHAPTER 421.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 106 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes," sub-title "Collateral Inheritance Tax," making the increase in the value of the estate subject to the Collateral Inheritance Tax.

(Vetoed.)

CHAPTER 422.

AN ACT to repeal Section 58A of Chapter 99 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1920, and to re-enact the same with amendments and to repeal Sections 267, 268, 269, 270, 271, 272 and 273 of Article 56 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Licenses," sub-title "Dog Licenses in the Counties," 1929 Supplement to the Annotated Code of Maryland, so far as said last named sections of said Article may be in conflict with said Section 58A of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Cambridge."

(Vetoed.)

CHAPTER 423.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 34 of Article 39 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Further Regulations in County Waters," relating to fishing in the Little Savage River in Garrett County.
