charged during the year included in said account which at the date of said account remain uncollected; and every such Register of Wills, the emoluments of whose office shall not amount to the sum of three thousand dollars in any one year, as aforesaid, may present a statement to the County Commissioners of his county, under oath, showing the net proceeds of his office, together with a statement of the cost of the necessary record books, stationery, contingent and office expenses and fuel used in his office up to the first Monday in June in each year; and the said County Commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to pay or levy for the use of said Register of Wills the amount of said books, stationery, contingent and office expenses and fuel, as aforesaid; provided, that the amount so paid or levied shall not, when added to the net proceeds of his office, exceed the sum of three thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1931.

## CHAPTER 427.

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to issue the certificates of indebtedness of said corporation to an amount not exceeding one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000), the proceeds of sale to be used for the purpose of enlarging, extending and improving the municipal conduit system of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, including the acquisition by purchase or condemnation of existing conduit systems, and of any and all land and property, and of any right, interest, franchise, easement or privilege therein, as may be necessary for the enlargement, extension and improvement of said municipal conduit system; authorizing the submission of an ordinance for the purpose to the legal voters of Baltimore City, such ordinance to provide for the expenditure of the proceeds of said loan, the rate or rates of interest to be paid thereon, and the manner of repayment thereof; providing for the method of expenditure of the proceeds of said loan, and declaring this Act to be an emergency law.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be and
