CHAPTER 430.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Licenses," subtitle "Motor Vehicles," sub-heading "Certificate of Ownership," said new section to be known as Section 202B and to follow immediately after Section 202A of said Article, authorizing the issuance to registered dealers of titles on motor vehicles purchased on a bill of sale outside of this State.

(Vetoed.)

CHAPTER 431.

AN ACT to add three new sections to Article 39 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Clams," same to follow immediately after Section 100 of said Article and to be known as Sections 101, 102 and 103, relating to the taking of clams in the waters of Worcester County; providing a license for catching and dealing in clams and providing a penalty for violations thereof.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That three new sections be and they are hereby added to Article 39 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1929 Supplement), title "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Clams," same to follow immediately after Section 100 of said Article, to be known as Sections 101, 102 and 103, and to read as follows:

101. Any resident or land owner of Maryland desiring to take or catch clams from the waters of Worcester County for sale shall first obtain a license from the clerk of the court of said county and shall pay the sum of \$5.00, and in addition thereto 25 cents to the clerk of the court for issuing same.

In addition to the license fee of \$5.00 above mentioned, he shall further pay as part of said license the sum of 5 cents per thousand on all clams caught by him and sold. This additional sum shall be paid to the dealer to whom the clams are sold; or if he shall sell direct to any person other than a licensed clam dealer the sum of 5 cents per thousand shall be paid to an inspector.
