

CHAPTER 441.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 5 of Article 17 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Clerks of Courts," sub-title "General Duties of Clerks," providing that it shall be unnecessary for the Clerks of Courts to attend office on legal holidays.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 5 of Article 17 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Clerks of Courts," sub-title "General Duties of Clerks," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:

5. Every clerk shall attend at his office for the transaction of the business thereof every day, except Sundays and legal holidays, either in person or by deputy, unless prevented by sickness, accident or necessity.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1931.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 25 of Article 39 of the Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland (Edition 1929 Supplement), entitled "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Tidal Waters," pertaining to the method of fishing in tidal waters; to repeal and re-enact Section 29 of Article 39 of the Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland (Edition 1929 Supplement), entitled "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Tidal Waters—Further Regulations in County Waters," prohibiting the use of nets or seines in certain waters of Sue's Creek; to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 71 of Article 39 of the Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland (Edition 1929 Supplement), entitled "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Non-Tidal Waters," providing seasons, manner and means of fishing in non-tidal waters; to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 76 of Article 39 of the Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland (Edition 1929 Supplement), entitled "Fish and Fisheries," sub-
