issue licenses shall forward monthly to the State Conservation Commissioner a complete list of all licenses issued on blanks to be furnished by said State Conservation Commissioner. The cost of said licenses shall be \$1.00 for each resident angler's license and \$5.00 for each non-resident angler's license, and in addition thereto the clerk shall collect and retain the sum of twenty-five cents for each resident license and fifty cents for each non-resident license for issuing same, and the balance of said fees shall be paid by said clerk at least once each month to the Comptroller of the State for the account of the Conservation Fund.

- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That if any clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Article shall, for any reason, be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional and invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph or section thereof so found unconstitutional and invalid.
- SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That all laws or parts of laws of the State of Maryland, general or local, inconsistent with the provisions of this Act be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

## CHAPTER 443.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 8 of Chapter 80 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1842, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Presbyterian Church at Rehoboth, Somerset County," increasing the amount of property which said corporation may acquire and hold.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 8 of Chapter 80 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1842, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Presbyterian Church at Rehoboth, Somerset County," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:
