sentenced to confinement in the Penitentiary for the period of his natural life, or he shall be sentenced to confinement in the penitentiary for not less than two years nor more than twenty years; and nothing in this section shall be construed to interfere with any prosecution that has or may hereafter be commenced for any violation of this section hereby repealed happening previous to June 1, 1931.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from June 1, 1931.
