

tion of such codification containing such ordinance, and conforms to the rules of law governing the framing of indictments for violation of Acts of the General Assembly of this State and concludes "against the form of the ordinance (rule or regulation) in such case made and provided, and against the peace, government and dignity of the State."

3. That the two members of the Board of County Commissioners elected from the Commissioner Districts Seven and Five shall maintain daily office hours during which they shall be in personal attendance at the county buildings which may be established by the Board of County Commissioners within their respective districts. The said Board is hereby authorized and directed, upon the recommendation of the County Commissioner representing the Seventh County Commissioner District, to appoint, discharge at pleasure and fix the compensation of a Deputy Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners; and upon the recommendation of the County Commissioners of the Fifth Commissioner District, to appoint, discharge at pleasure and fix the compensation of a Deputy Clerk to the said Board. Each Deputy Clerk shall be a resident of Montgomery County and each of said Deputy Clerks shall be on duty at the county buildings located in the Commissioner District for which he is appointed on every business day for not less than eight hours each day at such times as the Board of County Commissioners may direct and shall perform such duties as the said Board may require. The Board may also appoint such additional clerks and stenographers at such compensation as said Board may determine.

4. That, for the purpose of construction of roads, streets and highways within the said Montgomery County Suburban District, the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to issue serial coupon bonds on the faith and credit of said county, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00 (two hundred and fifty thousand dollars) par value. Such bonds shall be issued in denominations of \$100.00 or any multiple thereof and shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding five per centum per annum, payable semi-annually in each year during which said bonds shall be outstanding and remain unpaid and shall be signed by the President of the Board of County Commissioners of said county and by the clerk thereof, provided that the coupons for the interest thereon may be authenticated by
