

CHAPTER 482.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 122 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County," sub-title "County Commissioners," including additional fire companies to be levied for and increasing the amount to be levied for such fire companies in Frederick County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 122 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County," sub-title "County Commissioners," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

122. The County Commissioners of Frederick County are authorized and directed to levy on the assessable property of Frederick County for the year 1916 and annually thereafter the sum of \$2,200.00 to be paid on or before the first day of January in each and every year; \$200.00 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Independent Hose Company of Frederick, \$200.00 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Junior Steam Fire Engine Company of Frederick, \$200.00 of said sum to the Treasurer of the United Steam Fire Engine Company of Frederick, \$200.00 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Brunswick Volunteer Fire Company of Brunswick, \$200.00 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Vigilant Hose Company of Emmitsburg, \$200.00 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Guardian Hose Company of Thurmont, \$200.00 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Middletown Volunteer Fire Company, \$200.00 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Walkersville Volunteer Fire Company, \$200.00 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Mt. Airy Fire Company, and \$200.00 of said sum to the Treasurer of the New Mid Way Fire Company, and \$200.00 of said sum to the Treasurer of the Citizens Truck Company of Frederick, the said sums to be applied by the respective companies for their maintenance and support.

The County Commissioners for Frederick County, are authorized and empowered to levy on the assessable property of Frederick County, annually such additional sum or sums at the rate of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) each for any other
