

(f) To a gift of fifty shares of par value of \$100 each of 6½% First Preferred stock of the Commercial Credit Company from Custis W. Woolford, made in May, 1930, and to be known as the "Clara W. Woolford Memorial Fund."

(g) To the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Ninian S. Duncan, late of Baltimore City, deceased, of the principal sum of four thousand forty-two dollars and eighteen cents (\$4,042.18) and also interest in the amount of one thousand eight hundred sixty-eight dollars and eight cents (\$1868.08), together aggregating five thousand nine hundred ten dollars and twenty-six cents (\$5,910.26), to be known as the "Ninian S. Duncan Fund," said will being probated by the Orphans' Court for Baltimore City on February 10, 1921, and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for Baltimore City in Wills Liber H. W. J.
