

days during the months of November and December and on Sundays at any time of the year, reserving and adding, however, Wednesdays in the month of December as lawful days for shooting water fowl on said river and its tributaries between Wickes' Beach on Eastern Neck Island and Drum Point, so that Mondays and Fridays, during the month of November; Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays during the month of December; and Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays during the month of January, shall be lawful days for shooting water fowl on said river and its tributaries between Wickes' Beach on Eastern Neck Island and Drum Point, and provided further that on the Chester River and its tributaries above the Chester River Bridge and from the mouth of said river to Wickes' Beach at a point thereon dividing the properties of R. Nelson Stevens and Allan A. Harris and on the Bogles' Basin property, it shall be lawful to hunt water fowl every day during the months of November, December and January except on Sundays. It shall be unlawful to hunt wild fowl on any of the waters of Queen Anne's County during the month of November on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

And be it further provided, that it shall be unlawful to hunt water fowl on any of the waters of the Patuxent River and its tributaries, and on the waters of the Wicomico River in St. Mary's County during the open season, as provided herein on Tuesdays and Thursdays during the months of November and December.

(b) The migratory game birds specified in this section may be taken during the open season with a gun only, loaded with shot only not larger than number ten gauge, fired from the shoulder, from the land and water, with the aid of a dog or dogs, and the use of decoys; however, it shall be unlawful to use any airplane, sink box or sink boat, sneak boat, floating device, or any floating device towed by a power boat or a sail boat for the purpose of hunting water fowl, therefrom; provided, it shall be lawful to use sink box, sink boat, sneak boat or bushwhack rig on the Susquehanna Flats. And it shall be lawful to use sneak boat or bushwhack rig on the waters of the Elk and Sassafras Rivers in Cecil County. Any gun which cannot be habitually raised and fired from the shoulder and any gun larger than number ten gauge found in the vicinity of the resting and feeding areas of water fowl may be confiscated by any officer of this State and delivered to the Game Warden.
