ing unpaid after the expiration of the month of February shall bear interest from the first day of March, but all of such taxes paid during the months of March, April, May and June following their levy shall have the interest thereon remitted, but if paid on or after the first day of June following their levy the full amount of interest dating from the first day of March following their levy shall be charged and collected and placed to the credit of the county, as well as the principal of the taxes thus received; and the books of the collector shall be so kept as to show the amount assessed to each individual, the date of the payment thereof, and the amount received with interest. Provided, however, that if the first installment (one-half) of taxes shall not be paid on or before the first day of February following their levy, then and in that event the full amount of interest dating from the first day of September following their levy shall be charged and collected upon both the first and second installments of said taxes.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1931.

## CHAPTER 124.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 223, Chapter 315 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1906, and of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hancock."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 223, Chapter 315 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1906 and of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hancock," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:
