195. The County Commissioners of Montgomery County shall each receive for his services, the sum of \$1,800.00 per annum, payable monthly in equal installments.

CHAPTER 169.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 323 of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Larceny—Dogs," to make anyone convicted of feloniously taking and carrying away a cat guilty of the crime of larceny.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 323 of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Larceny—Dogs," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

323. Every person convicted of feloniously taking and carrying away any dog, bitch, or cat, or as accessory thereto before or after the fact shall be deemed guilty of the crime of larceny, and shall restore the dog, bitch, or cat, to the owner thereof, or shall pay to him the value thereof, and shall be sentenced to confinement in jail for not more than three months.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1931.
