

CHAPTER 292.

AN ACT to prohibit the sale, manufacture and/or firing of firecrackers, squibs, rockets and other combustible fireworks in the Seventh Election District of Montgomery County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, partnership, association or body corporate to manufacture, sell or offer for sale any firecrackers, squibs, rockets or other combustible fireworks within the limits of the Seventh Election District of Montgomery County after January 1st, 1932.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to fire, detonate, set off or burn any firecrackers, rockets, squibs or other combustible fireworks within the limits of the said Seventh Election District of Montgomery County at any time other than on July first to fourth, inclusive.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That any person or persons, association, or body corporate violating any of the provisions of this Act, upon conviction before the Police Justice of Montgomery County or in the Circuit Court of Montgomery County, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall pay a fine not to exceed the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each offense.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1931.
