spectors; it being the intention of this Act to take out of the Classified Service of the State, and out of the State Merit System, such offices and places and personnel as were added to same by the recent executive order of the Governor, in the manner provided by Code, Article 64A, Section 21.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1939.

## CHAPTER 516.

## (House Bill 511)

AN ACT to fix the rate of State taxation for each of the years nineteen hundred and forty (1940) and nineteen hundred and forty-one (1941), in accordance with the provisions of Section 30, Article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the rate of State taxation for each of the years nineteen hundred and forty (1940) and nineteen hundred and forty-one (1941), respectively, is hereby fixed in the manner following, and the taxes for each of the State loans herein specified to be used to pay the installments of principal and interest thereon.
