

CHAPTER 557.

(House Bill 768)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 170 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Capitol Heights", increasing the compensation of the Treasurer of Capitol Heights.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 170 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Capitol Heights", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:

170. And the said Treasurer shall receive as a full compensation for the discharge of his duty a sum of two hundred dollars per annum.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1939.

CHAPTER 558.

(House Bill 105)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 38 of Article 16 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Chancery", sub-title "Divorce", as said Section was amended by Chapter 396 of the Laws of 1937, to eliminate one of the grounds for divorce.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 38 of Article 16 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Chancery", sub-title "Divorce", as said Section was amended by Chapter 396 of the Laws of 1937, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows:

38. Upon a hearing of any bill for a divorce, the court may decree a divorce a vinculo matrimonii for the following causes, to wit: first, the impotence of either party at the time of the marriage; secondly, for any cause which by the laws of
