- SEC. 19. And be it further enacted, That if any section, clause or provision of this Act should be declared by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or inoperative, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause or provision of this Act, is being hereby declared that the several sections, clauses and provisions of this Act are severable, and that the remainder of this Act would have been enacted had the General Assembly known such section, clause or provision was unconstitutional or inoperative.
- Sec. 20. And be it further enacted, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and health, and being passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths (3/5) of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 652.

(House Bill 685)

- AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 35 of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1935 Supplement), title "Workmen's Compensation", sub-title "Application of Article; Extra-Hazardous Employments", providing that the officers and enlisted men of the organized militia of the State shall be deemed workmen of the State for wages within the meaning of said section.
- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 35 of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1935 Supplement), title "Workmen's Compensation", sub-title "Application of Article; Extra-Hazardous Employments", be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
- 35. Whenever the State, county, city or any municipality shall engage in any extra-hazardous work, within the meaning of this Article, whether for pecuniary gain or otherwise, in which workmen are employed for wages, this Article shall be applicable thereto. In time of peace and while engaged in military service all officers and enlisted men of the organized militia of the State of Maryland shall be deemed workmen of
