abolish the offices of State Engineer, Senior Assistant State Engineer, Junior Assistant State Engineer, and the positions of any employees in the State Department of Mechanical Engineering.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 128 to 131, inclusive of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1935 Supplement), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments," sub-title "Department of Engineering," be and the same are hereby repealed, and the offices of State Engineer, Senior Assistant State Engineer, Junior Assistant State Engineer, and the positions of any employees in the State Department of Mechanical Engineering, be, and the same are hereby abolished.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect on June 1st, 1939.

CHAPTER 166.

(House Bill 60)

AN ACT to exempt, for a period of two years, the Emmitsburg Railroad Company from all state taxes and from all county taxes in the County of Frederick.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Emmitsburg Railroad Company shall be exempt from all state taxes and from all county taxes in the County of Frederick for a period of two years from January 1, 1939.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1939.

CHAPTER 167.

(House Bill 80)

AN ACT to repeal and reenact with amendments Section 80 of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1935 Supplement), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments," sub-title "State Librarian," requiring the State Librarian to supply one copy of the Maryland reports to the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City.
