

one year fifty cents on each hundred dollars' worth of assessable property.

68. Whenever the Commissioners shall levy, a tax, they shall cause to make out alphabetical list of the persons charged therein, and shall cause to be affixed thereto the respective sums to be collected from such persons and a warrant to the bailiff to collect the same, and the said bailiff shall have the power of distraint as collector of county taxes.

69. The bailiff shall make all collections required of him, and pay the same to the clerk, within six months from the time the tax bill is placed in his hands.

70. The Commissioners shall not expend or contract to expend, in any one year, more money than the amount receivable from taxes and other sources for that year, except such amounts as may be derived from the sale of bonds, etc., for water works, sewers, or other public improvements.

71. The County Commissioners, justices of the peace, sheriff, constables, and all State and county officers shall have, hold and exercise their offices and jurisdiction in said town as if this charter had not been granted.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and being passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all of the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 343.

(Senate Bill 426)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 620 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County", sub-title "Teachers Salaries", as said section was amended by Chapter 37 of the Acts of 1933 (Special Session), relating to the compensation of certain teachers employed in the public schools of Allegany County.
