CHAPTER 596.

(Senate Bill 502)

- AN ACT to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to sundry gifts, bequests and devices contained in the Last Wills and Testaments of certain persons, deceased, and also to certain gifts, grants, sales, leases and deeds made by various persons to and for the use and benefit of sundry ministerial persons, religious corporations, educational institutions, denominations or sects, and to certain charitable institutions hereinafter named.
- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sanction and consent of said General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby declared, given and granted to the following gifts, bequests, devises, grants, sales, leases, conveyances and deeds, to and from certain persons and bodies corporate to and for the use of certain ministerial persons, religious and educational corporations, orders, denominations and sects, and to certain charitable institutions hereinafter named as herein set forth:

- 3. To devises and bequests contained in the Last Will and Testament of Frances Stuart, late of Baltimore City, deceased, under her Will dated September 8, 1937 to Most Reverend Michael J. Curley, Archbishop of Baltimore; Associated Professors of Loyola College; Catholic Foreign Missionary Society, Inc., Mary Knoll, New York; Congregation of the Mission of St. Vincent de Paul Society of Baltimore City; House of Good Shepherd of Baltimore City; Pastor of St. Ignatius Church, Baltimore; St. Ignatius Church, Baltimore; Institute of Mission Helpers of Baltimore City; The Redemptorists of St. Michael's Church; St. Francis DeSales Church of Benedict, Maryland; St. Peter Claver's Church of Ridge, Maryland; St. Vincent's Catholic Church, Berkley Springs; St. Vincent's
