United States of America, a body corporate, situate at Loysville, in the State of Pennsylvania, the sum of Six hundred dollars (\$600.00) in cash, under the fourth item of the said Will.

- (d) To The Inner Mission Society of The Evangelical Lutheran Church of Baltimore City and Vicinity, Incorporated, a body corporate, all the rest, residue and remainder of the property and estate of the said deceased, of whatsoever kind, nature and description, real, personal and mixed, and wheresoever the same may be situate, under the eleventh item of the said Will.
- 108. To the gift, devise and bequest contained in the Last Will and Testament of Henry D. Eidman, late of the City of Baltimore, deceased, said Will being dated July 29, 1935, and duly recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for Baltimore City in "Wills" Liber J. H. B. No. 199, Folio 443, etc., as follows:

(a) To St. Paul's English Lutheran Church, a body corporate, the sum of One thousand dollars (\$1,000.00)

in cash, under the third item of the said Will.
