To the gifts and bequests made and contained in the Last Will and Testament of Mary Jane Leonard, late of Baltimore City, deceased, said Will being dated June 25, 1931, and having been duly admitted to probate by the Orphan's Court of Baltimore City on March 5, 1941, and now recorded in the office of the Register of Wills of Baltimore City, in Wills Liber, J. H. B. No. 201, Folio 480, as follows:—

(a) To Propagation of the Faith, a corporate body, for Masses to be said for deceased persons designated in said Will, the sum of \$500.00 in cash, absolutely.
