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CHAPTER 673.

(House Bill 806)

AN ACT to repeal Section 489 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County", sub-title "Notaries".

WHEREAS, the Article 68 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), makes provision for the appointment of notaries generally; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 489 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County", sub-title "Notaries", be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941.

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CHAPTER 674.

(House Bill 808)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 630-636, inclusive, of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County", sub-title "Trespass", said sections relating to the driving of horses, hogs, sheep, or black cattle on the lands of others West of Savage River.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 630-636, inclusive, of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Alle-
