

County", sub-title "Salisbury—Water and Sewers", as amended by Chapter 428 of the Acts of 1937, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

325. The Mayor and Council of Salisbury shall provide for each and every property abutting upon a street or right-of-way in which, under this Act, a water main or sanitary sewer is laid a  $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch water service pipe or a 6-inch sanitary sewer connection, which shall be extended as required from the water main or sanitary sewer to the property line of the abutting lot, said service pipe or connection to be constructed by and at the sole expense of the Mayor and Council of Salisbury. Water service lines in excess of  $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch in diameter and sanitary sewer service lines in excess of 6 inches in diameter, will be constructed at the property owners' request and expense, said cost to be determined by the Mayor and Council of Salisbury. When any water main or sewer is declared by said Mayor and Council of Salisbury complete and ready for the delivery of water or the reception of sewerage, every abutting owner shall, after due notice make connection of all spigots or hydrants, toilets or waste drains (not including roof drains or storm water drainage) with said water main or sewer within a time prescribed by said municipality. Where the aforesaid fixtures do not exist or are of a nature which, in the judgment of the Mayor and Council of Salisbury, is improper or inadequate, satisfactory equipment shall be installed. All cesspools, sink drains and privies shall be abandoned and left in such a way that they cannot again be used or injuriously affect the public health, said disposition to be determined by the Mayor and Council of Salisbury, and all wells that are found by the Mayor and Council of Salisbury to be polluted or a menace to health shall likewise be abandoned and closed. Any violation of the provisions of this section shall be a misdemeanor punishable under Section 330 of this sub-title.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941.
