CHAPTER 12.

(Senate Bill 21)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 7 to 11, inclusive, of Article 80 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Reporter and Codifier—State", said sections relating to the codification of the laws by the Court Reporter.

Whereas, these sections have never been availed of and are obsolete; therefore

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 7 to 11, inclusive, of Article 80 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Reporter and Codifier—State", be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect on June 1, 1941.

CHAPTER 13.

(Senate Bill 32)
