an investigation of said alleged pollution of the Potomac River at and below Alexandria, Virginia, and to take such steps as may be found possible and desirable to abate such conditions; and be it further

Resolved, That copies of this Resolution be sent to all of the governmental agencies and bodies mentioned herein.
