ballot, and also on such ballot shall appear the name or names of the candidate or candidates for Councilmen arranged alphabetically, and immediately following the words "For Councilman", shall be printed on said ballot, and preceding the name or names of the candidate or candidates shall be plainly printed in black ink a direction to the voters "Vote for one by marking a cross (X) mark in that square which is opposite the name of the candidate to be voted for", and a black line shall be printed immediately under the name of each candidate extending to a square opposite the name of the candidate and immediately under the names of the candidates or candidate there shall be printed a black line extending to a square on which the voter may insert in writing the name of a candidate for Councilman, if he so desires, which name may not already be printed on the ballot.

There shall be a separate ballot for each ward, and the ballots of no two wards shall be printed on the same color

paper.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941.

CHAPTER 231.

(Senate Bill 95)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 918 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland and Baltimore City Charter (1938 Edition), title "Baltimore City", sub-title "Police Examiners", providing that members of the police force shall be given extra leave of absence for certain overtime work.

CHAPTER 232.

(Senate Bill 258)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 737 and 738 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland and Baltimore City Charter (1938 Edition), title "Baltimore City", sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables", relating to vacation and sick leave of the Police Justices of Baltimore City.
