the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Montgomery County", sub-title "Maryland-Washington Regional District", said new section to be known as Section 690A, and to follow immediately after Section 690 of said Article, relating to the application of the Montgomery County Building Code in the Maryland-Washington Regional District.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new section be and it is hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws of Montgomery County (1939 Edition—being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland) title "Montgomery County", sub-title "Maryland-Washington Regional District', said new section to be known as Section 690A, to follow immediately after Section 690 of said Article, and to read as follows:

- 690A. The Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County may, in their discretion, by a duly recorded resolution adopted by a majority vote at a regular meeting of said Board, make its rules and regulations commonly known as "The Building Code" effective in that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District which now lies or hereafter may lie within Montgomery County.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941.
