- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 75 of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Cecil County", subtitle "Cecilton", be, and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
- 75. The town treasurer may enforce the payment of town taxes in the same manner and with the like effect as collectors of State and county taxes may enforce the payment of State and county taxes, including, but not limited to, the power to sell or otherwise dispose of property against which unpaid taxes have been levied; such sale to be advertised and held in the same manner as is provided elsewhere in this Article for the sale or other disposition of property against which unpaid taxes have been levied by the county.
- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act be, and they are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- Sec. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941.

CHAPTER 43.

(Senate Bill 7)

AN ACT to repeal Section 286 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Licenses", sub-title "Check Rooms".

Whereas, the license on check rooms produces such a small revenue that it does not justify the trouble and effort to enforce its provisions; therefore

- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 286 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Licenses", sub-title "Check Rooms", be and the same is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect on June 1, 1941.
