

CHAPTER 44.

(Senate Bill 9)

AN ACT to repeal Section 288 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Licenses", sub-title "Shoe Shining Parlors and Hat Cleaning Establishments".

WHEREAS, the above licenses produce such a small revenue that it does not justify the trouble and effort to enforce its provisions; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 288 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Licenses", sub-title "Shoe Shining Parlors and Hat Cleaning Establishments", be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect on June 1, 1941.

CHAPTER 45.

(Senate Bill 10)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 776, 777 and 778 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1938 Edition), title "Baltimore City", sub-title "Horse Dealers".

WHEREAS, the provisions relating to the licensing of horse dealers are obsolete and no longer applicable; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 776, 777 and 778 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1938 Edition), title "Baltimore City", sub-title "Horse Dealers", be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect on June 1, 1941.
