

CHAPTER 480.

(Senate Bill 142)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, subsections (n) and (o) of Section 1 of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Alcoholic Beverages", defining "Hotel" and "Restaurant".

(Vetoed.)

CHAPTER 481.

(Senate Bill 157)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 866-868, inclusive, of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County", sub-title "Wolves and Foxes", relating to the payment of bounties for the killing of wolves.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 866-868, inclusive, of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County", sub-title "Wolves and Foxes", be, and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941.

CHAPTER 482.

(Senate Bill 158)

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 72 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1939 Edition), title "Oysters", sub-title "Tonging", said new section to be known as Section 7A and to follow immediately after Section 7 of said Article, making it unlawful to catch or take oysters in the waters of Calvert County in the area known as Flag Pond Rock, except by ordinary rakes and tongs.
