

an official clerk who shall be a person well qualified in the vocation of double-entry bookkeeping, and to have the fiscal records and accounts of said clerk, together with those of the Treasurer and Tax Collector of said town, audited annually by a certified public accountant.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941.

CHAPTER 57.

(Senate Bill 107)

AN ACT to repeal Section 345 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Carroll County", sub-title "Spectacles and Eyeglasses", said section relating to licenses for the sale of spectacles and eyeglasses.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 345 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Carroll County", sub-title "Spectacles and Eyeglasses", be and it is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 58.
